AN ACT CONCERNING PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN FELONY VIOLATIONS OF ELECTION LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that certain
- 2 felony violations of election laws shall carry a penalty of a minimum
- 3 term of imprisonment of twelve months that may not be suspended or
- 4 reduced.

Statement of Purpose:

To impose one-year mandatory minimum prison sentences for certain felony violations of election laws.
