**AN ACT CREATING A STATE PROCUREMENT STANDARD FOR THE
USE OF LOW-EMBODIED CARBON CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS IN
CERTAIN STATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Departments of
- 2 Administrative Services and Transportation to create a procurement
- 3 standard preferring the use of low-embodied carbon concrete, mass
- 4 timber and other low-carbon construction materials in any state
- 5 construction project administered by said departments.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce carbon emissions by requiring the development of a
procurement preference standard for the use of low-embodied carbon
construction materials in certain state construction projects.
