## AN ACT CREATING A STATE PROCUREMENT STANDARD FOR THE USE OF LOW-EMBODIED CARBON CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS IN CERTAIN STATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Departments of 2 Administrative Services and Transportation to create a procurement 3 standard preferring the use of low-embodied carbon concrete, mass 4 timber and other low-carbon construction materials in any state 5 construction project administered by said departments.

## Statement of Purpose:

To reduce carbon emissions by requiring the development of a procurement preference standard for the use of low-embodied carbon construction materials in certain state construction projects.
