AN ACT CONCERNING PROOF OF IDENTITY, CITIZENSHIP AND RESIDENCY FOR PURPOSES OF VOTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that (1) prior 2 to being admitted as an elector, including during same-day election 3 registration, each person shall present to an election official proof of 4 such person's (A) United States citizenship, and (B) Connecticut 5 residency, and (2) prior to receiving and being able to cast a ballot, each elector shall present to an election official a current and valid photo 6 7 identification, which identification clearly displays such elector's name 8 and residential address.

Statement of Purpose:

To require (1) persons to present proof of United States citizenship and Connecticut residency prior to registering to vote, and (2) electors to present photo identification prior to voting.
