AN ACT DESIGNATING TUSKEGEE AIRMEN DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-29a of the general statutes be amended to designate
- 2 April twenty-sixth of each year as Tuskegee Airmen Day, to recognize
- 3 the significant contributions of the first African American military
- 4 fighter pilots in American history who served during World War II, and
- 5 whose impressive performance earned them more than one hundred
- 6 fifty Distinguished Flying Crosses.

Statement of Purpose:

To honor the Tuskegee airmen for their brave service during World War
II by designating an annual day of recognition for them.
