## AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF ACCESSIBLE SEATING FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED PERSONS AT VENUES THAT RECEIVE STATE FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Administrative 2 Services shall conduct a study concerning requiring venues that receive 3 state funding to provide seats for visually impaired persons close to 4 performance areas. Such study shall include, but not be limited to, 5 which types of venues should be subject to such requirement, the 6 potential costs of such requirement and any barriers to achieving 7 compliance with such requirement. Not later than February 1, 2026, the 8 commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions 9 of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee 10 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to 11 government administration. Such report shall include the results of such 12 study and any recommendations for necessary legislation.
