AN ACT CONCERNING CANNABIS USE PREVENTION EFFORTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) provide that for the fiscal 2 year ending June 30, 2025, and each fiscal year thereafter until June 30, 3 2029, five per cent of collections for the tax imposed on total THC shall 4 be redirected from the General Fund to the Cannabis Prevention and 5 Recovery Services Fund, (2) expand the permitted uses of the moneys in 6 said fund for the purpose of preventing youth cannabis use, and (3) 7 require the Connecticut Alcohol and Drug Policy Council to establish a 8 cannabis health review panel to examine the effects of cannabis use.

Statement of Purpose:

To (1) redirect additional funds to, and expand the permitted uses of the moneys in, the Cannabis Prevention and Recovery Services Fund, and (2) require the Connecticut Alcohol and Drug Policy Council to establish a cannabis health review panel.
