AN ACT CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR PERMITS AND TOBACCO BARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 30-22a of the general statutes be amended to (1) reduce
- 2 the minimum municipal population requirement for tobacco bars from
- 3 eighty thousand to forty thousand, and (2) reduce the square footage
- 4 requirements applicable to tobacco bars by fifty per cent.

Statement of Purpose:

To (1) reduce the minimum municipal population requirement for tobacco bars from eighty thousand to forty thousand, and (2) reduce the square footage requirements applicable to tobacco bars by fifty per cent.
