## AN ACT CONCERNING INSTRUCTORS FOR AN AIRFRAME AND POWERPLANT CERTIFICATE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2025) The Connecticut Technical 2 Education and Career System shall permit any person to be an instructor 3 for an airframe and powerplant certificate program operated by said system who (1) meets the requirements specified in 14 CFR 147.19, and 4 5 (2) if such person holds an airframe and powerplant certificate, has not 6 less than ten years of experience as an aerospace technician. Nothing in 7 this section shall be construed to require a person to hold any 8 certification or endorsement from the Department of Education to be an 9 instructor for an airframe and powerplant certificate program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following<br/>sections:Section 1July 1, 2025New section

To specify the qualifications for instructors for an airframe and power plant certificate program operated by the Connecticut Technical Education and Career System.
