## AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WHO RECEIVE ANY STATE FUNDING TO ACCEPT CASH PAYMENT FOR SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that health care
- 2 providers who receive any state funding (1) accept cash payment for
- 3 health care services and related fees, including, but not limited to,
- 4 parking fees, and (2) provide change up to fifty dollars.

## Statement of Purpose:

To mitigate the effects on persons without a credit card of prohibiting the use of cash to pay for treatment and related services by health care providers who receive any state funding.
