AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID COVERAGE FOR PAN-ETHNIC SCREENING FOR PATIENTS WHO ARE PREGNANT OR PLANNING A PREGNANCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require Medicaid
- 2 coverage for pan-ethnic screening for Medicaid-eligible persons who are
- 3 pregnant or planning a pregnancy in which screening is conducted for
- 4 potential genetic disorders for all individuals regardless of ethnicity.

Statement of Purpose:

To update and clarify documentation requirements for carrier screening preauthorization coverage to remove barriers to medically necessary prenatal care for Medicaid beneficiaries in the state.
