**AN ACT CONCERNING AN EQUITABLE MEDICAID AUDIT, BILLING
AND REIMBURSEMENT POLICY FOR PHARMACIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Social Services (1) not to use extrapolated data from
- 3 Medicaid audits of pharmacies stemming from clerical errors or errors
- 4 caused by minor technicalities for the purposes of denying Medicaid
- 5 reimbursements, (2) to provide a receipt confirmation for consequential
- 6 notices regarding pharmacy billing, (3) to maintain a reliable database
- 7 of preferred drug lists that is updated with real-time information
- 8 regarding denials and approvals of such preferred drug lists, and (4) to
- 9 utilize a functional and appropriate appeals process for appeals in
- 10 which the reimbursements do not cover the pharmacy costs.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure a fair process for pharmacies regarding Medicaid billing and
reimbursements.
