**AN ACT CONCERNING STATE-FUNDED RESPITE CARE FOR
PARENTS OF CHILDREN WITH AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide state-funded respite
- 2 care for parents of children with autism spectrum disorder similar to
- 3 state-funded respite care provided to children with an intellectual
- 4 disability administered by the Department of Developmental Services.
