## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO MITIGATE THE BENEFITS CLIFF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the recommendations of a benefits cliff study by the two-2 generational initiative established pursuant to section 17b-112l of the 3 general statutes be implemented by (1) establishing, not later than 4 January 1, 2026, a three-year pilot program to mitigate the effects of the 5 benefits cliff on two hundred eligible families participating in public 6 assistance programs, and (2) a report by the two-generational initiative 7 not later than January 1, 2028, on the status of the program to be filed 8 with the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having 9 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state 10 agencies, children, labor and public employees and human services.

## Statement of Purpose:

To mitigate benefits cliffs that occur when participants in public assistance programs lose benefits after their income surpasses certain thresholds.
