AN ACT REQUIRING STATE-FUNDED FAMILY PLANNING SERVICES PROVIDERS TO FILE A LEGISLATIVE REPORT ON SERVICES PROVIDED AND ANY REPORTS OF SEXUAL ABUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require any family planning services provider that receives funding provided or administered by the state to file a report with the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to human services on (1) the number and type of services provided, and (2) any reports of sexual abuse reported to or by such provider involving a patient provided state-funded services.

Statement of Purpose:

To require family planning services providers that receive state funding to submit information detailing the services they provide and any incidents of sexual abuse reported by or to such provider involving a patient provided state-funded care.
