AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CIVIL PENALTY FOR A MUNICIPALITY'S FAILURE TO MEET THE THRESHOLD FOR THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING APPEALS PROCEDURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 8-30g of the general statutes be amended to establish a civil penalty between twenty-five thousand dollars and fifty thousand dollars against any municipality that does not meet the ten-per-cent threshold for the affordable housing appeals procedure, with such funds to be used to support municipalities with housing shelters and affordable housing initiatives.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a penalty against any municipality that does not meet the ten-per-cent threshold for the affordable housing appeals procedure.
