AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF CREDIT HISTORY OR RACE IN UNDERWRITING AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY OR HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to enact further protections for consumers to prohibit any automobile liability or homeowners insurance company from using credit history or race in underwriting or rating automobile liability or homeowners insurance policies.
