AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR OUT-OF-NETWORK GROUND TRANSPORT AMBULANCE CHARGES.

- 5 ambulance charges for which health carriers are not obligated to
- 6 provide coverage.
