**AN ACT PROHIBITING STATE AGENCIES FROM TAKING CERTAIN ACTIONS AGAINST PARENTS AND GUARDIANS WHO CHOOSE TO RAISE CHILDREN CONSISTENT WITH THEIR BIOLOGICAL SEX.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any state agency,
- 2 including, but not limited to, the Department of Children and Families,
- 3 from investigating a claim of child abuse or neglect, removing a child
- 4 from such child's home or denying or revoking a child's foster or
- 5 adoptive placement if the basis for such investigation, removal, denial
- 6 or revocation is solely related to the decision of such child's parent,
- 7 guardian or prospective guardian to raise such child in a manner
- 8 consistent with such child's biological sex.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit state agencies from taking certain action against a parent or guardian if the basis for such action relates solely to such parent's or guardian's decision to raise a child consistent with such child's biological sex.
