AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSUMPTION OF ENERGY DRINKS BY CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a working group 2 to study the (A) medical risks associated with children consuming 3 energy drinks, and (B) anticipated effects of a prohibition on the sale of 4 energy drinks to children, public health and the state-wide sale of 5 energy drinks, (2) require the Department of Consumer Protection to 6 develop signage alerting consumers to the medical risks associated with 7 children consuming energy drinks and retailers to post such signage, 8 and (3) require the Department of Public Health to develop a one-page 9 document explaining the medical risks associated with children 10 consuming energy drinks for distribution to pediatricians and licensed 11 athletic trainers.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a working group to study the medical risks associated with the consumption of energy drinks by children and effects of a prohibition on the sale of energy drinks to children, require signage related to the medical risks associated with the consumption of energy drinks by children and require a document explaining the medical risks associated with the consumption of energy drinks by children.
