AN ACT REQUIRING DISCLOSURES CONCERNING THE TERMINATION OF CERTAIN FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2025*) For any fund or account that is (1) established pursuant to a public or special act, (2) administered by the state, a state agency or a department, institution, bureau, board, commission, authority or official of the state, and (3) intended for a charitable purpose, such administrator shall, to the extent practicable, disclose to the General Assembly prior to the termination of such fund or account:

- 8 (A) The intent to terminate such fund or account, and
- 9 (B) An estimate of the anticipated balance of such fund or account at 10 the time of termination, if any.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require certain disclosures regarding the termination of funds and accounts that are established pursuant to a public or special act, administered by the state, a state agency or a department, institution, bureau, board, commission, authority or official of the state, and intended for a charitable purpose.
