AN ACT CONCERNING THE QUANTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS FROM NET-ZERO, DECARBONIZATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL AND GOVERNANCE MANDATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of 2 Energy and Environmental Protection to itemize and quantify the 3 specific environmental benefits that all net-zero, decarbonization and 4 environmental, social and governance mandates will achieve, as well as 5 the scientific evidence of such benefits and their direct and indirect costs 6 to taxpayers and businesses.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to itemize and quantify the specific environmental benefits that all netzero, decarbonization and ESG mandates will secure, the scientific evidence of such benefits and their direct and indirect cost to businesses and taxpayers.
