AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE-WIDE SPOTTED LANTERNFLY CONTROL PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a state-wide 2 spotted lanternfly control program through a two-hundred-fifty-3 thousand-dollar fund that enables municipalities to apply for grants of 4 up to five thousand dollars for the purpose of control efforts such as tree 5 bands and traps, approved insecticide applications and visual 6 reconnaissance surveys and egg mass scraping.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for spotted lanternfly control efforts.
