AN ACT CONCERNING THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF ANIMALS SOLD AT PET STORES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that: (1) No pet shop 2 shall sell any animal from a breeder or pet dealer found to have 3 committed any direct or indirect violation of pet dealer-related 4 regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture during the 5 seven-year period prior to such purchase, and (2) the Commissioner of 6 Agriculture submit a report reach year to the joint standing committee 7 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the 8 environment that indicates the number of violations of such prohibition 9 that the Department of Agriculture issued for the previous calendar year and the nature of each such violation. 10

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance oversight of the sale of animals in pet shops.
