AN ACT CONCERNING THE DIVERSION OF ORGANIC MATERIALS FROM THE WASTE STREAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a state-wide 2 municipal waste management program to support the diversion of food 3 from the waste stream through donation programs, feeding animals or 4 livestock, composting and anaerobic digestion. Additionally, to 5 establish a five-million-dollar fund, through bonding, to provide for 6 grants of up to one hundred thousand dollars to support such programs.

Statement of Purpose:

To fund programs that divert food from the waste stream.
