**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF REBATES UNDER THE
CONNECTICUT HYDROGEN AND ELECTRIC AUTOMOBILE
PURCHASE REBATE PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22a-202 of the general statutes be amended to have the
- 2 rebate attach to the individual consumer rather than the product itself,
- 3 such that if the consumer returns the product they may still utilize the
- 4 rebate and attendant credits.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit manufacturers from retaining state funds under consumer environmental incentive programs in the case of returning the item back to its manufacturer or retailer, and allow the individual to qualify for the credit again when purchasing another qualified item.
