AN ACT REQUIRING ELECTRIC SUPPLIERS TO OBTAIN SURETY BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require that any third-party 2 electric supplier obtain a surety bond in the amount of five hundred 3 thousand dollars in order to operate in the state, and if any such supplier 4 makes door-to-door solicitations to potential customers, to require that 5 such supplier obtain an additional surety bond in the amount of five 6 hundred thousand dollars. The surety bonds required under this section 7 shall guarantee that any such supplier follows all pertinent state and 8 local laws and regulations.

Statement of Purpose:

To require third-party electric suppliers to obtain surety bonds to ensure compliance with state and local laws.
