AN ACT PROHIBITING LOBBYIST CONTRIBUTIONS TO LEGISLATORS OR STATE OFFICERS RUNNING FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICE DURING A LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 155 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit 2 during any regular, special or reconvened session of the General
- 3 Assembly any lobbyist, or any political committee established by or on
- 4 behalf of a lobbyist, from making or offering to make a contribution for
- 5 the benefit of a member of the General Assembly or a state officer who
- 6 is a candidate for nomination or election to a municipal office.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit lobbyist contributions to legislators or state officers running for municipal office during a legislative session.
