**AN ACT REDUCING THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE THC CONTENT OF CANNABIS AND CANNABIS PRODUCTS SOLD TO CONSUMERS IN THE RECREATIONAL CANNABIS MARKET.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 420h of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 no cannabis establishment shall sell to any consumer any cannabis
- 3 flower, cannabis plant material or other cannabis product with a total
- 4 THC concentration, calculated on a dry-weight basis, that is greater than
- 5 fifteen per cent.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that no cannabis establishment shall sell to any consumer any cannabis flower, cannabis plant material or other cannabis product with a total THC concentration, calculated on a dry-weight basis, that is greater than fifteen per cent.
