AN ACT CONCERNING FAMILY HOME-CARE SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To require the Commissioner of Social Services to (1) study the
- 2 administration, oversight and outcomes of state-administered home-
- 3 care programs, (2) compensate family caregivers, including spouses,
- 4 who provide personal care assistance services in the state-funded
- 5 portion of the Connecticut home-care program for the elderly, (3) collect
- 6 and report on data regarding adult family living services in the state,
- 7 and (4) develop and implement a marketing campaign to promote adult
- 8 family living services.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve home-care services in the state, allow more senior citizens to age in place at home and avert state costs on institutional care.
