## AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCOME THRESHOLD FOR TENANTS RENTING A DWELLING UNIT IN A SET-ASIDE DEVELOPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 8-30g of the general statutes be amended to permit any person or family renting a dwelling unit in a set-aside development to continue renting such dwelling unit for not more than three years after such person's or family's income exceeds an amount that would otherwise disqualify such person or family from renting such dwelling unit.

## Statement of Purpose:

To permit a tenant renting a dwelling unit in a set-aside development to continue renting such dwelling unit for three years after such tenant's income exceeds the statutory income threshold.
