***AN ACT CONCERNING A LANDLORD'S ABILITY TO ENTER A
DWELLING UNIT FOR THE PURPOSES OF SHOWING SUCH UNIT TO
POTENTIAL PURCHASERS OR TENANTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 47a of the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit a
- 2 tenant from refusing, for six or more consecutive days, to allow a
- 3 landlord to enter such tenant's dwelling unit for the purpose of selling
- 4 or renting such dwelling unit, and (2) provide that such tenant's refusal
- 5 for six or more consecutive days constitutes a breach of the rental
- 6 agreement, entitle the landlord to possession of such dwelling unit and
- 7 prove a basis for a summary process eviction.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit a tenant from refusing to allow a landlord to enter such tenant's dwelling unit for the purposes of showing such dwelling unit to potential purchasers or tenants.
