AN ACT CONCERNING A LANDLORD'S ABILITY TO ENTER A DWELLING UNIT FOR THE PURPOSES OF SHOWING SUCH UNIT TO POTENTIAL PURCHASERS OR TENANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 47a of the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit a tenant from refusing, for six or more consecutive days, to allow a landlord to enter such tenant's dwelling unit for the purpose of selling or renting such dwelling unit, and (2) provide that such tenant's refusal for six or more consecutive days constitutes a breach of the rental agreement, entitle the landlord to possession of such dwelling unit and prove a basis for a summary process eviction.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit a tenant from refusing to allow a landlord to enter such tenant's dwelling unit for the purposes of showing such dwelling unit to potential purchasers or tenants.
