**AN ACT ASSISTING PARENTS CURRENTLY INCARCERATED FOR
NONVIOLENT CRIMES IN FOREIGN JURISDICTIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow an individual
- 2 convicted of a nonviolent crime in a foreign jurisdiction, who is
- 3 incarcerated for such crime in that jurisdiction, and has children
- 4 residing in this state, to be transferred to a state correctional facility to
- 5 serve the remainder of their sentence as close to their children as
- 6 reasonably possible, depending on the safety and needs of such
- 7 children.

Statement of Purpose:

To assist parents currently incarcerated for nonviolent crimes in foreign
jurisdictions.
