AN ACT CONCERNING JUDICIAL REVIEW OF PROBATION SENTENCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 54 of the general statutes be amended to allow judicial
- 2 review of probation sentences after five years of successful completion
- 3 and for a reduction or termination of probation after a hearing and for
- 4 good cause shown.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow judicial review to terminate or reduce probation for those with mandatory probation sentences after five years of successfully completed supervision.
