**AN ACT REQUIRING STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO  
COOPERATE WITH THE FEDERAL OFFICE OF IMMIGRATION AND  
CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require: (1) The Department
- 2 of Correction to notify the United States Office of Immigration and
- 3 Customs Enforcement (ICE) and all other federal authorities regarding
- 4 the detention or transfer of an undocumented immigrant in the
- 5 department's custody; and (2) the Division of State Police, Department
- 6 of Correction or a municipal police department to immediately notify
- 7 Immigration and Customs Enforcement upon first contact with an
- 8 undocumented immigrant for whom a detainer request or final
- 9 deportation order has been issued and to detain such individual until
- 10 such time that ICE assumes custody.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require that state law enforcement agencies cooperate with the Office  
of Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
