AN ACT REQUIRING STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO COOPERATE WITH THE FEDERAL OFFICE OF IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require: (1) The Department 2 of Correction to notify the United States Office of Immigration and 3 Customs Enforcement (ICE) and all other federal authorities regarding the detention or transfer of an undocumented immigrant in the 4 5 department's custody; and (2) the Division of State Police, Department 6 of Correction or a municipal police department to immediately notify 7 Immigration and Customs Enforcement upon first contact with an 8 undocumented immigrant for whom a detainer request or final 9 deportation order has been issued and to detain such individual until 10 such time that ICE assumes custody.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that state law enforcement agencies cooperate with the Office of Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
