AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 567 of the general statutes be amended to (1) update the
- 2 wage threshold for unemployment benefits eligibility in section 31-235
- 3 of the general statutes, (2) adjust such wage threshold annually based
- 4 on inflation, and (3) exempt agricultural employers from participation
- 5 in the unemployment compensation system unless such employers
- 6 satisfy the compensation threshold in subparagraph (H) of subdivision
- 7 (1) of subsection (a) of section 31-222 of the general statutes for at least
- 8 two consecutive quarters in a calendar year.

Statement of Purpose:

To update the basis for an individual to qualify for unemployment benefits and exemptions for agricultural employers from participation in the unemployment compensation system.
