AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPALITIES AND THE PAID SICK LEAVE STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That sections 31-57r to 31-57w, inclusive, of the general statutes be amended to require municipalities to provide paid sick leave to their employees who do not currently receive at least forty hours of paid leave. Such requirement shall not supersede any collective bargaining agreement or employer policy regarding incremental usage of paid sick leave or the requirement of a doctor's note when using paid sick leave.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend the paid sick leave statutes to include municipalities.
