**AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO DISPLAY A POSTER
CONTAINING INFORMATION ON VETERANS' BENEFITS AND
SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2025*) Each employer shall
- 2 display a poster in a conspicuous place, accessible to employees, at the
- 3 employer's place of business that contains information regarding
- 4 benefits and services available to veterans in the state. The Labor
- 5 Commissioner, in consultation with the Commissioner of Veterans
- 6 Affairs, shall create a model of such poster and make such model
- 7 available to all employers on the Labor Department's Internet web site.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
