AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO DISPLAY A POSTER CONTAINING INFORMATION ON VETERANS' BENEFITS AND SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2025*) Each employer shall display a poster in a conspicuous place, accessible to employees, at the employer's place of business that contains information regarding benefits and services available to veterans in the state. The Labor Commissioner, in consultation with the Commissioner of Veterans Affairs, shall create a model of such poster and make such model available to all employers on the Labor Department's Internet web site.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:Section 1October 1, 2025New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Labor Department to create a standardized workplace poster containing information on veterans' benefits and services for employers to display in the workplace. [Proposed deletions are enclosed in brackets. Proposed additions are indicated by underline, except that when the entire text of a bill or resolution or a section of a bill or resolution is new, it is not underlined.]
