AN ACT CONCERNING PAID PRENATAL LEAVE FOR PREGNANT EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 31 of the general statutes be amended to require employers
- 2 to provide twenty hours of paid leave, in addition to any other leave
- 3 provided, to pregnant employees for pregnancy-related health care,
- 4 including, but not limited to, prenatal checkups, ultrasounds and other
- 5 pregnancy-related appointments.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure mothers receive prenatal care without putting their jobs at risk.
