AN ACT CONCERNING MINORS WHO HAVE REACHED THE AGE OF FIFTEEN WORKING IN RETAIL STORES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 31-23 of the general statutes be amended to allow a
- 2 minor who has reached the age of fifteen to be employed or permitted
- 3 to work in a mercantile establishment under the same conditions as a
- 4 minor who has reached the age of fifteen employed in a retail food store.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow fifteen year olds to work in retail stores under the same conditions as fifteen year olds employed in grocery stores.
