**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM WAGE RATE FOR PERSONS  
UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (5) of subsection (i) of section 31-58 of the general
- 2 statutes be amended to (1) reduce the minimum wage rate for persons
- 3 under the age of eighteen years, with the exception of emancipated
- 4 minors, from eighty-five per cent to seventy-five per cent, and (2)
- 5 eliminate the ninety-day limitation of such minimum wage rate.
