AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM WAGE RATE FOR PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That subdivision (5) of subsection (i) of section 31-58 of the general statutes be amended to (1) reduce the minimum wage rate for persons under the age of eighteen years, with the exception of emancipated minors, from eighty-five per cent to seventy-five per cent, and (2) eliminate the ninety-day limitation of such minimum wage rate.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the minimum wage rate for persons under the age of eighteen years and eliminate the ninety-day limitation of such minimum wage rate.
