AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE CONNECTICUT-TAIWAN TRADE COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a Connecticut-
- 2 Taiwan Trade Commission to (1) advance bilateral trade and investment
- 3 between the state and Taiwan, (2) initiate joint action on policy issues of
- 4 mutual interest to the state and Taiwan, (3) promote business and
- 5 academic exchanges between the state and Taiwan, (4) encourage
- 6 mutual economic support between the state and Taiwan, (5) encourage
- 7 mutual investment in the infrastructure of the state and Taiwan, and (6)
- 8 address such other related matters as determined by the commission.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a Connecticut-Taiwan Trade Commission.
