***AN ACT CONCERNING A LIMITATION ON THE COSTS CHARGED TO
A SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PROVISION OF SPECIAL
EDUCATION SERVICES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to provide that the
- 2 cost to a local or regional board of education for the outplacement of
- 3 special education students is capped at the greater of two times the per
- 4 pupil cost of the average student in the school district at that same grade
- 5 level, or three times the per pupil amount for the town of such school
- 6 district under the equalization aid grant formula; and further that title
- 7 10 of the general statutes be amended to require local and regional
- 8 boards of education to be required to pay the greater of one-third the
- 9 average cost per special education pupil in that grade or one-half the per
- 10 pupil amount for the town of such school district under the equalization
- 11 aid grant formula, whichever is higher so long as the student is testing
- 12 at grade level for each student who is home-schooled or enrolled in a
- 13 nonpublic school or a charter school, provided such student is testing at
- 14 grade level.

Statement of Purpose:

To cap the costs for the outplacement of students in special education programs and to require boards of education to be financially responsible for certain special education students.
