AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO SOUTH CENTRAL CHIEFS OF POLICE ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN TRACKING TECHNOLOGY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate 4 two hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used 5 by the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection for the 6 purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to South Central Chiefs of Police 7 Association, Inc. to permit said association to offer grants to municipal 8 police departments in the south central region of the state to pay fifty 9 per cent of the cost of acquiring StarChase or similar technology for 10 tracking car thieves and thieves using stolen cars to commit other 11 crimes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to municipal police departments in the south central region of the state to pay fifty per cent of the cost of acquiring certain technology to track cars.
