**AN ACT REQUIRING THE AUDITORS OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS TO  
REVIEW THE COSTS OF PROVIDING CERTAIN PUBLIC AND  
PRIVATE SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL  
DISABILITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 That the Auditors of Public Accounts be required to (1) conduct a  
2 review of the cost of providing public and private services, both  
3 residential and day, to individuals with intellectual disabilities, who are  
4 clients of the Department of Developmental Services and receive  
5 twenty-four-hour care in community or institutional settings, to  
6 determine the most cost-effective means to deliver those services, to  
7 update the findings of the 2012 report of the Legislative Program  
8 Review and Investigations Committee, and (2) submit a report with the  
9 results of such review to the joint standing committee of the General  
10 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to government  
11 oversight.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Auditors of Public Accounts to review the costs of  
providing public versus private services to individuals with intellectual

disabilities, to update the findings of the 2012 report of the Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee.
