AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER ACCESS TO PHARMACIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that any insurance
- 2 company allow any covered person to have options of not less than
- 3 three independent or retail pharmacies within a five-mile radius of such
- 4 covered person's residence for such covered person to have any
- 5 prescription filled.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that any insurance company allow any covered person to have options of not less than three independent or retail pharmacies within a five-mile radius of such covered person's residence for such covered person to have any prescription filled.
